



Energy Technology

The energy industry currently generates more than £90 billion from domestic and international markets. This figure is expected to rise to £200 billion in 2030. The industry currently employs 600,000 staff, with an anticipated increase to one million in 2030. In addition to the continuing importance of oil and gas, other sources of energy are now being tapped. The UK Government's renewable energy strategy provides the basis for a £100 billion investment in renewables by 2020.
